Presenter: Todd Burke is an emergency services trainer and coach whose law enforcement career spans 35 years as a patrol officer, deputy sheriff, field training officer, tactical team operator, tactical paramedic team leader, and certified police generalist instructor with the Missouri Department of Public Safety. He holds a wide variety of certifications in law enforcement, the fire service, and emergency medical services. Todd has been in the forefront of training emergency first Enforcement Training Institute at the University of Missouri in Columbia since 1985 and he was a volunteer firefighter-paramedic for 22 years in Boone County retiring in 2005 as a decorated battalion chief. Todd has provided expert witness testimony to support high-profile felony and capital crime prosecutions and he has competed internationally in civilian and police firearms competitions since the age of 14.

Todd is currently the firearms and tactical medical programs manager for Strategos International, a position he has held for 14 years. Since 2004, Todd has developed training courses for schools, churches, bus transportation services, and businesses for dealing with intruder response and the threat of an active shooter.

Todd lives in Hallsville, Missouri with his wife Joan (also a 30-year emergency services veteran) and two daughters, Farley and Fiona. The Burkes are active members of the Rocky Fork Fellowship Church in Hallsville and Todd is the director of the life safety ministry for his church.
